## UNIFORM GUIDELINES 2018 – 2019

(Revised May 2016)

Students at Rosewood Magnet know that we gain respect through the way we present ourselves and interact with others. The uniform look is clean and neat. We observe good grooming habits, wear appropriate hairstyles, tuck in shirttails, and coordinate accessories with the uniform. Students are expected to follow the guidelines of the district and school dress code policies.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS SHALL BE OF THE FOLLOWING STYLES AND COLORS MARKED WITH A ♦:

<i>Shorts, Skorts, Capris and Slacks</i> – Plain twill / cotton with belt loops or elastic waist (Shorts and skorts MUST extend beyond finger length.)	♦	♦	♦

**Shoes** – must be closed toe and closed heel, sneakers are recommended. Shoes must be laced or velcro-ed if applicable.

### Dress Code Guidelines

- Only the **Rosewood logo** may appear on clothing. **Other logos, pictures, or wording are not acceptable.**
- **All shirts must be tucked in.**
- Slacks, shorts, skirts, and skorts with **belt loops require a belt.** Belts must be black, brown, navy, khaki, grey or white.
- Shorts, capris, skirts and skorts **must extend beyond finger length.**
- Oversized or extremely short styles are not permitted.
- **Shoes:** For safety reasons, **flat - closed toe and closed backed shoes or sneakers** are the only footwear allowed. Skate shoes/heellies, boots, flips flops, or crocs are not allowed at school.
- Socks must be worn with shoes or sneakers. Socks must be white, black, brown, navy, khaki or grey. Socks must be visible above shoes.
- Make-up, body glitter, tattoos, trendy or dyed hair and/or head scarves are not allowed. Head bands and hair accessories should be minimal in size and should not be distracting to the learning environment.
- Jewelry must be appropriate and safe for school. (No large, dangling, or distracting jewelry should be worn.)
- Traditional, straight-legged blue denim **jeans/shorts** may be worn on **Fridays only** with Spirit Shirt or uniform shirt. Jeans and shorts should not be torn, frayed, sequined or have logos.
- Hats are not permitted during the school day. They may be worn during outdoor P.E. activities or recess as authorized by administration.
- Removable clothing should be **clearly labeled.**

Uniform clothing may be purchased at the Uniform Shop, Scott's Sporting Goods or the uniform sections of Target, Wal-Mart or other department stores
